A list of people arriving in SA from 1836 to 1952 derived from various sources including newspapers, formal shipping records, immigration records, and records of deserters from ships. More details in Documentation.

Hodge Index: A list of passengers arriving at Port Adelaide from South Australian coastal and intercolonial ports between 1837-1845. This list was originally compiled by SAGHS Volunteer Mary M. B. Hodge.
