Newspaper marriage, approaching marriages engagement or wedding anniversary









What is in the German Cards database?

This dataset contains summary information about nineteenth century immigrants from Germany to South Australia, and their descendants. The original collection of cards was compiled by a group of volunteers coordinated and led by Dulcie Love (1916-2009). Other contributors were Bob Badenoch, Edna Bawden, Robert Blair, Bob Bowker, Pat Button, George Daw(e)s, Dianne Haynes, Shirley Kalisch, Betty Possingham, Aileen Preiss, Wolfgang Preiss, Helen Slater, Frieda Welke, Joan Amos, Jill Booker, Keith Lokan and Kingsley Neumann.

1st card abbreviations: B=Birth, M=Marriage, SP=Spouse, L=Lived, D=Death, PAR=Parents, ZEI=Zeitung (Newspaper).

2nd card abbreviations (references): BI=Birth index, CEM=Cemetery, CH REC=Church records, DATE=date revised (e.g. 6/06 for June 2006), DI=Death index, EUR COLL=European & Germanic folders, FH=Family history, GER COLL=Germanic & European folders. HARZ REC=Migration records, MI=Marriage index, NAT=Naturalisation, PL=Passenger lists, REC=Records.

In many cases, the upper right text on the card (sometimes entered by hand) shows the arrival ship for first generation immigrants.

What is in the Wreschen Records database?

Baptisms, Burials and Marriages

These datasets are derived from the parish records from the Evangelical Church in the Wreschen region in the years 1819 to 1874.

The Wreschen Parish in Posen, Prussia (now in Poznań, Poland - the town of Wreschen is now Września). Many of the early German immigrants to South Australia came from the Wreschen region.

The registers are written in a combination of German and Old German and are difficult to read, even for those of us who can read a little German. Thankfully, the transcribed records cover much of the information in the registers, although there are a number of errors and uncertainties in the transcriptions.

Note that although the records have been transcribed, they have not been translated, and are in German.


What is in the Irish Born South Australians (IBSA) database?

The IBSA dataset contains information about persons born in Ireland who immigrated to South Australia in the 1800's. It also includes the first generation born in SA and their children where available. These persons were identified by their descendants and other interested people, so the coverage is patchy.

It will also include people who are not of Irish ancestry but are there as they married a person of Irish ancestry and they complete a family group.

The effort in checking and correlating these records has been limited, and mainly aimed at reducing the large number of potential duplicates which were in the initial dataset. Consequently the information is presented 'as is' and users are warned that they should seek further information from other sources to support the data found here.
